Quite a counter-cultural understanding of greatness, but the one that defines what it means to be Christian. It may not be the competition we wanted to enter, but it's the one we're in if we want to share in the glory of God.

Puede que no sea la competencia en la que queríamos participar, pero es en la que estamos si queremos compartir la gloria de Dios.
